A free event



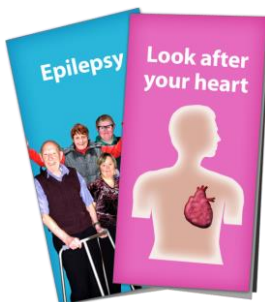
The Learning Disabilities Observatory has been working on a new project.
